2. Lenguages



English

Primary & Secondary

Extracurricular English classes aim to reinforce and improve the level acquired at school. The little ones will have fun learning English, while the older ones will work to build a solid foundation of the language and encourage spontaneous speaking, preparing the student for their first official qualifications.

55€/month 10 months (2h/week). Primary: Alternate days depending on the level from 1:00 pm to 2:30 pm. Secondary: Friday from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm

Français

Introduction to French with an entertaining and motivating method to introduce the student into a third language.

40€/month 9 months (2h/week). Alternate days depending on the level from 5:00 pm to 6:00 pm

Chinese

Kidergarten & Primary

Learning Chinese stimulates the logical-mathematical thinking of students. They learn to express themselves and interact in simple, everyday situations. In the class there will be activities related to music, poetry and Chinese calligraphy.

Chess

Public speaking offers techniques, activities and strategies to learn how to speak in public. The activity includes emotional intelligence exercises, voice and posture training body language, communication techniques and gradual exposure to spectators.

Musical theatre in English

Primary & Secondary

Through musical theater, students will work on body expression techniques, diction, personal and social acting skills, singing and choreography. Thanks to the fusion of all techniques, students learn to control their body and movement in order to express feelings and interpret different characters. All while improving their vocabulary and fluency in English.

Music for tiny people

Kindergarten & Primary 1

Musical activity based on active methodologies. In class, students sing, dance, play instruments, learn musical language and create their own compositions.

Kindergarten & Primary | Secondary

Dance develops children's creativity, and helps to interact with other people, to work on elasticity, organizational skills, harmony and balance, and concentration.

Drawing and painting in English

Kindergarten, Primary & Secondary

Kindergarten

Group and individual instruments

Primary & Secondary

Learning to play an instrument in a group promotes cooperative learning, in which all the problems that arise in the class are put together and resolved as a group. Classes can be held in a group (minimum 5 students), in a small group (maximum 4 students) and individually. (Each student has to bring their own instrument).
